SUMMARY

Work undertaken with assistance from the grant to improve student well-being and success and how it supported the Student Success Plan (SSP):

The funds from the Healthy Schools Grant were used to increase student activity outside, promote outdoor learning, increase school spirit, and provide culturally enriching experiences. The four-square courts very popular. We created two courts and could probably add a third because there are often big line-ups to play. The hot tent and stove were purchased later in the year and not used yet, but we have a teacher on staff who's very interested in outdoor learning and has plans to regularly use it next year. The water bottles with the school logo on them were at hit and came in useful when our fountains were down, and students had to use the bottled water filling stations.
